Sandra Gallina joined the European Commission in 1988.

She is today Director General for Health and Food Safety (DG SANTE).

Before joining DG SANTE, between 2018 and 2020 she was Deputy Director General for DG TRADE.

Between 2014 and 2018 she was Director for DG TRADE Directorate D "Sustainable development, Economic Partnership Agreements - APC, Agri-food and Fisheries". Ms Gallina was also the EU chief negotiator for EU-MERCOSUR Free Trade Agreement.

Between 2001 and 2009 she was the EU lead Negotiator for non-agricultural market access in the WTO Doha Round and in that capacity, she defined and presented EU policy for the Doha Development agenda on non-agricultural market access negotiations.

Before joining DG TRADE, she worked in the DG TAXUS at the end of the 1990s.
